When parts are joined in an assembly process, the seller shall prepare an "Assembly Configuration & Serialization Log" identifying each part in the assembly by specification/drawing part number and revision level, including Aerojet furnished parts, when applicable. Standard purchase parts shall be lot controlled. Fabricated parts shall be identified with serial number, lot number, heat number, drawing and specification with applicable revision letter or number. Components in the assembly shall be traceable to records of acceptance by part number, serial number, lot number, of material from which the components were fabricated by the Supplier, and shall accompany parts they represent to Aerojet.
